

**Last-minute changes** to the flyer schedule:

- ◆ **Daily Morning 199er games added!** (8:45 am, Tuesday thru Saturday)! This makes three games a day for under-200 players!
- ◆ **Sunday 199er Swiss Teams** is actually two separate events, not one long event. Play one or both: 9:00am and 1:30pm.
- ◆ **StratiFlighted Events:** the top strat of the second flight is 1000-1500, not 1000-5000 as printed.

**Oops Department:** Two big goofs yesterday. I forgot to include the added Saturday event this year, the Berry Delight Compact Knockout Teams in yesterday's back page "Tomorrow's Schedule." As penance, I plan to play in the event today!

The other error was in the hard *Galaxies* puzzle on page 23 yesterday. One (at least one, but one is enough) of the dots was misplaced, making the puzzle impossible (I think). Lesson learned: starting today, I am importing the puzzles as a screen capture from the excellent free software suite they come from (see page 2 for details), instead of making them myself with the tools in Microsoft Publisher. **58 IMPs (with two pushes) in one Swiss Teams Match!** *Lynda Cole* told me about a wild match in last night's Swiss where she began by doubling 2♣ on the first board. It was redoubled and made an overtrick for -760 and thirteen IMPs away. Good start. A few hands later, the chance to get it back: 6♠ redoubled on these cards:

♠T98 ♥AQ987x ♦Ax ♣Qx

Heart led vs 6♠

♠AKJxxx ♥x ♦Kx ♣Kxxx

Lynda won the ace in dummy and continued with the Q♣. This play proved to be key: LHO took the ace, continued with a heart, Lynda inserting the seven to draw the ten, ruffed in hand. Lynda cashed the ace of spades and the king of clubs and ruffed a club. Returning with the K♦, Lynda ruffed her last club in dummy, and RHO discarded. This placed the Q♠ in LHO's hand, and the only way to kill it was to try and drop it doubleton...

Welcome to Penticton! We're a bit down from the excellent attendance of last year, but yesterday's influx of weekend players made a turnaround possible. Penticton's Regional has been the 6th, 8th, 5th and 7th largest in the ACBL over the past four years (highest in Canada since 2003).

Entries are sold at the Directors' table in the main room for all morning events and all team events, with pair game entries being sold outside by the snack bar. The uncarpeted half of the room is set up for teams (tables at an angle), and the carpeted area is set up for pairs events (with perpendicular tables).

No need to sign in at the Hospitality Desk, but check back often for news about what's happening. There's a great selection of menus for nearby restaurants, plus information on "extra-curricular" activities (winery tours, golf, and other options), plus the usual information on other tournaments, which we encourage you to take home to your local clubs.

Door prizes are being handed out every session to random players in the form of tickets that you redeem at the Hospitality Desk for a prize. They are listing the winners near the hospitality desk alongside the list of tournament sponsors.

Yesterday's speaker was **Matt Smith**, our Director-In-Charge here in Penticton, the latest installment in the ongoing series called **Director Please!**

With the 199ers games going so well this year, an extra speaker has been added for Saturday evening: **Jade Barrett** of Elk Point SD, will give another entertaining talk from his entertaining series **It's All In Your Head**.

**When is it open?** The snack bar, outside the "teams" end of the playing area, is open from 7:30am — 2pm and again from 7 — 9 pm daily. The evening bar, mid-way down the corridor, is open from 6pm to closing every day. The Hospitality desk is open for door prize claims from 11:45am to 12:45 pm, and again daily from 6pm to 7pm. Entry-sellers begin their work about 45 minutes before each session.

If you fulfill #1, #3 shouldn't be a problem...



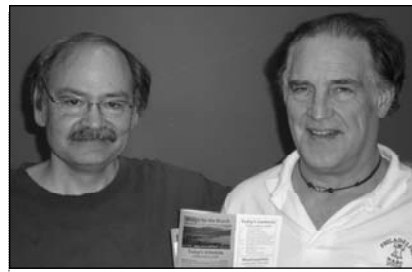
**Donna Gorda** of Crossfield AB became a new Life Master in the knockouts on Friday.

## DINO Recorder

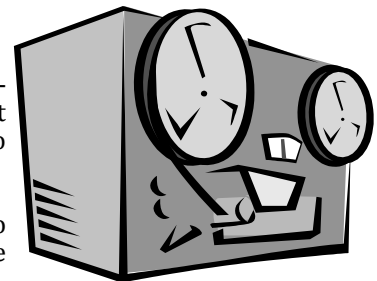
The main role of the Recorder is to receive written information, complaints and suggestions by players about other players, tournament directors, tournament facilities and anything else directly related to bridge.

### The Recorder's Duties:

- The Recorder keeps ongoing records of all grievances brought to his attention, the facts of which he is able to verify. Absolute confidentiality is observed.
- The Recorder has no punitive powers. If a hearing does take place, however, the Recorder's records may be made available to the Committee as evidence.
- The Recorder will review memos received and determine how the issue is to be acted upon. He may investigate to determine the facts and possible extenuating circumstances.
- The Recorder acts as an educator. Many players do not understand ethics and rules. The Recorder is able to help newer players, and others, become aware of each player's ethical responsibilities.

If you wish to report to the Recorder, you do so by obtaining a Player Memo form from a Director. All Player Memos should be completed as fully as possible and returned to a Recorder or to a Director.
