When is it open? The snack bar, outside the "teams" end of the playing area, is open from 7:30am — 2pm and again from 7 — 9 pm daily, although these times are approximate. The evening bar, midway down the corridor, is open from 6pm to closing every day. (Don't hold me to this on Sunday though.) The Hospitality desk is open for door prize claims from 11:45am to 12:45 pm, and again daily from 6pm to 7pm, but not following the evening session. - ◆ **Thursday Open Pairs:** the second session begins at 7:15 pm like all the other events; ignore the schedule, which claims a 7:00 start.

Welcome to Penticton! Or, if you were here last week for the Canadian Bridge Championships, thanks for staying. This is my fifth set of Penticton Daily Bulletins and my twentieth Regional Daily Bulletin job, since my rookie job at the Vancouver 2000 Regional, and I hope to make the anniversary set a personal best.

In addition to picking up your copy at the tournament site—expected arrival time is mid to late morning—you'll be able to view the Bulletins online every morning, minutes after they are finished. And photos taken for the Bulletin are posted at a special site online where you can download them or even order printed copies to be sent to you. I look forward to taking lots of photos at a tournament where there are sure to be lots of winners!

Please come to the Bulletin office at lunch hour or following the evening session if you have won an event or finished first overall in any bracket or strat — especially if you are a new Life Master or have passed a plateau to one of the higher Life Master categories. It doesn't matter if your partner or teammates is unavailable or if the win happened several days ago; come anyway!

Informational items: Almost everyone here has been here before, but even if you are here for the first time, there's little trouble finding the Partnership Desk, Hospitality Desk, and Booksellers table in the spacious foyer. Entries are sold at the Directors' table in the main playing area for all morning events and all team events, with pair game entries being sold outside near the cafeteria. As you walk into the playing area, you'll see that the uncarpeted half of the room is set up for teams (tables at an angle), and the carpeted area is set up for pairs events (with perpendicular tables). The Bulletin Office is located across the foyer from section A, outside the far end of the pairs side of the room.

No need to sign in at the Hospitality Desk, but check back often for news about what's happening. There's a great selection of menus for nearby restaurants, plus information on "extra-curricular" activities (winery tours, golf, and other options), plus the usual information on other tournaments. Grab an apple!

Over one hundred door prizes are being handed out every session to random players in the form of tickets that you redeem at the Hospitality Desk for a prize. There probably will not be enough room to list all of the winners in the Bulletin, but there will be a handwritten

Monday Evening Charity Pairs

Brian Lee and Richard Kay top five sections of pairs!

A fourteen-table increase in the Monday night open pairs game was the best news possible for the hard-working local organizers. **Brian Lee** and **Richard Kay**, from neighbouring cities across the Fraser River about a hour's drive out of Vancouver, had a superb game to take first in A and B, while **Christine** and **Samuel Orchard** of Yachats OR took the under-500 strat with nearly 57%.

District policy, I believe, is to score across the field in all open games, but over no more than three sections. So a game with four or more sections will be split at gametime into two or three-section groups (usually alphabetically, I would imagine) for section tops. The size of the group, of course, determines how many pairs each direction win masterpoints and how many at the top get gold points. So there really isn't an advantage in being in a three-section group or a two-section group. As you can see below, both groups paid masterpoints in Flight A down to about 51%.

Winning score: 656.50 on a 38 top. **Average** for the one session was 494.

To make the overalls you needed a score of 610.28 (A), 581.50 (B), 511.00 (C).

Prognostic explanation
