When is it open? The snack bar, outside the "teams" end of the playing area, is open from 7:30am — 2pm and again from 7 — 9 pm daily, although these times are approximate. The evening bar, midway down the corridor, is open from 6pm to closing every day. (Don't hold me to this on Sunday though.) The Hospitality desk is open for door prize claims from 11:45am to 12:45 pm, and again daily from 6pm to 7pm, but not following the evening session. Entry-sellers begin their work about 45 minutes before each session (call it 30 minutes in morning sessions). The Partnership Desk will spring into action about half an hour before each afternoon and evening session, but there is a corkboard and a supply of Partners Needed cards there all day.

- ◆ **Daily Morning 199er games** (8:45 am, Tuesday thru Saturday)! This makes three games a day for under-200 players!

- ◆ **Thursday Open Pairs:** the second session today begins at 7:15 pm like all the other events; ignore the schedule, which claims a 7:00 start.

Informational items: Almost everyone here has been here before, but even if you are here for the first time, there's little trouble finding the Partnership Desk, Hospitality Desk, and Booksellers table in the spacious foyer. 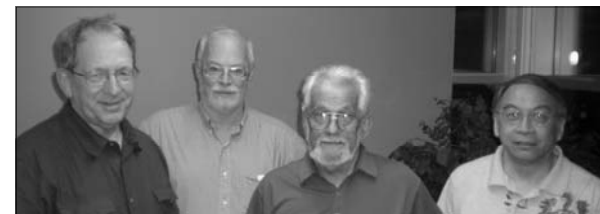
Winning score: 1252.25 on a 38 top. **Average** for two sessions was 988.

Beautiful boards!

Please help us make them last!

All of us could do a better job in ensuring that our beautiful metal boards last. Commonly-seen infractions involving duplicate boards include the following:

Turning played boards over on the stack. The felt bottom on metal boards is there so that when they are stacked normally, the felt polishes the top of the board below. Turned over, you have felt polishing felt, and metal scratching against metal. The stickers on the top of the board come loose when they rub up against metal. And while they lie on the table upside-down, a card may be exposed to someone walking by: you can tell an honor from a spot card from the thumb niche in the bottom.

Many players don't like to have too many boards in the table stack. Fine, but please don't take the boards to be played later and drop them on the floor from a height of several feet! Or toss them to the next table without getting up! You'd never do this with a stack of CDs; why it is OK for a stack of boards? Unnecessary dents and paint chips reduces their lifespan. Get a chair and put boards on it. Or bend a little.

The stickers on boards, and especially the cards in them, often need to be replaced after thoughtless players finish a quickie meal from KFC and begin play without so much as a wipe. **Lynda Cole** will tell you with great horror about the tournament where they offered corn on the cob in the middle of a session...

A little common sense from everyone will make our bridge equipment go a long way. Please be considerate.
