can send in a gust of wind that tosses all the flyers to the floor. It may seem like only a few seconds exposure to one person, but when one does it, others follow, and the foyer temperature plummets with the doors wide open for an extended period of time. The automatic temperature control then heats the foyer...and broils the playing area!

There is one more edition of the Daily Bulletin after this one, the online-only Wrapup Issue. It will contain Sunday results, photos of winners I take on Sunday as I sleep through the Swiss Teams, and complete masterpoint lists for the tournament, including an alphabetical list of everyone who won points and what colour their points were. The Wrapup Issue should be ready by late evening tonight. All of the other issues, are posted online too, with hand records and complete results from each pair game (results from each board, with names, posted beside the hand itself).

Lynda Cole and I have collaborated on a new convention that everyone should add to their system, because it solves a common problem:

The McBruce convention: East-West takes their pencils with them.

Like most modern stuff, you can play a 'reversed' version just to throw people off:

Reverse McBruce: East-West leaves their pencils at their old table and picks up new ones at their new table.

Of course, chaos results if the East-West pairs don't collude beforehand and decide what they're going to play. Linda's solution:

McBruce with Cole adjunct: East-West count the number of pencils at the table and take theirs with them if there are five or more, but leave the pencils at the table if there are four or less.

This should work.

Reminder: check the Partnership Desk area before you leave for flyers to take back to your local clubs, to help spread the word about future tournaments. Every little bit helps!

Location of today's events: The single session events and the Senior Swiss Teams will be in the Guildford Ballroom. The other Swiss Team events will be held in the Fraser and Barnston Rooms.

The snack bar outside the Fraser and Barnston rooms (the playing area behind the restaurant) is open from 9:30am to 2pm today. Sunday's Swiss Teams plan has changed somewhat since the flyer was printed.
